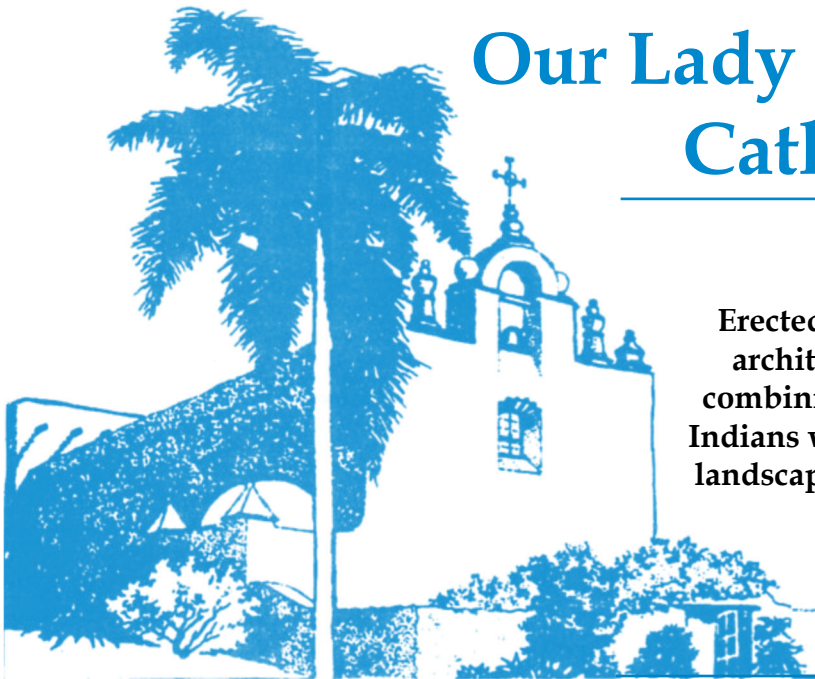




Our Lady of Mount Carmel Catholic Church

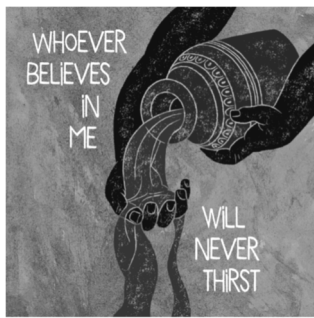
Whole Community Faith Sharing

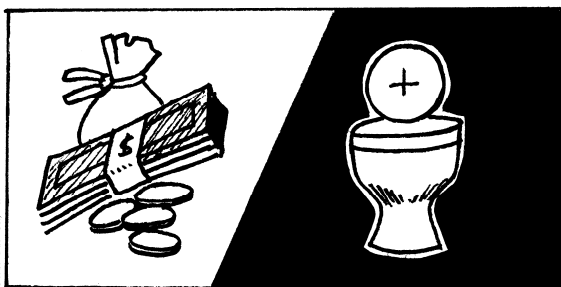
Question: How do I partake of the nourishment that Jesus provides? How often?
