

Gospel John 1:35~42



<u>Reflection</u>: How many of us feel troubled that, unlike the apostles, we aren't ready to drop everything and follow Jesus? It is difficult to understand the apostles' faith to drop the way of life they grew up with, their security, and even their old identities Jesus promised them other bigger nets, they believed, and they went. But if you read further in the gospels, you realize how much the apostles still had to learn as they became disciples. They often misunderstood Jesus, competed to be closest to Jesus, and Peter even publicly denied him. So perhaps when Jesus calls each of us to "Come, follow me," as we take those first steps, remember it's a journey; there may be some faltering. Sometimes, we will be strong, and sometimes, we feel that we can't quite see the way, but we must never forget that we can find the way We just need to listen to the one who keeps beckoning, "Come, follow me". Question: What part of my life is Jesus calling

me to change right now? **Faith Response**: Each day this week, I will pray and ask Jesus how I can be a better follower.


