Gospel Luke 12:49~53



Reflection: Reflection: In today's Gospel, it makes us uncomfortable to hear Jesus say that he has come not for peace but for division-"to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!" Is this some other Jesus, or do his words make us realize that here is a man of passion who so desires the coming of God's kingdom that he can't wait for that to happen? Fans of country music might recall a song by Garth Brooks called "Standing Outside the Fire." In the refrain, he sings, "Standing outside the fire / Standing outside the fire / Life is not tried – it is merely sur~ vived / If you're standing outside the fire." Jesus' incarnation shows us that He surely does not stand outside. His desire is the complete opposite of coolness and control. Love requires self-sacrifice. This is why the Sacred Heart of Jesus is often depicted as a heart on fire, burning with love for us.

Question: How can I share my burning love for Jesus and help ignite the world?

Faith Response: This week I will meditate on the heart of Christ. Contemplate his goodness, his justice, his mercy, his courage and his sufferings. And most of all, his self-emptying and self-sacrificing love for me.









SAFEGUARD OUR CHILDREN Back to school safety tips.

As your children head back to school, parents should begin laying the groundwork (if they haven't already) for open communication about the school's safety guidelines and policies.
