Whole Community Faith Sharing

Gospel Luke 16:1~13



Reflection: The gospel reading this week is a powerful reminder of living with honesty and faithfulness. It calls us to put God above money and use what we have to serve others. Wealth and possessions are not bad, but they should never control us. God wants us to act with fairness, care for the poor, and live in a way that reflects His love.

Let us draw wisdom from a homily by Franciscan Friar, Father Larry Janowski, who eloquently explains the gospel.

Some seminarians were sitting around in the recreation room. Their casual conversation soon turned to kidding one another, as young men do. Each one got ragged over some minor matter: One was a champion at procrastination, another was getting caught up in fantasy football, and so on. Finally, they turned to John. John had recently taken a part-time job at a local women's college, working in the library. Knowing that John was a solid guy who also really enjoyed women's company, they held forth on how he should be concerned about his vows. After all, several nights a week, he was "surrounded by all those young women." John played along, finally saying, "Well, if you guys can compromise on poverty with expensive cell phones or obedience by sneaking out to bars after hours, then so can I with celibacy."

A priest who was in the room, pretty much unnoticed, noisily put down his newspaper and looked directly at all the young men: "If you compromise one vow, you compromise them all." There was silence. No one became defensive or argumentative, and no one justified their behavior by saying, "We were just kidding." They knew he was right. They recalled Jesus' words: "You cannot serve two masters."

<u>Question:</u> In what ways do you feel exploited or tricked – as a citizen, family member, a consumer or a church member?

<u>Faith Response:</u> This week I will reflect if there is any group I have exploited or was tempted to exploit and follow Paul's advice and pray to lead a life of tranquility and dignity.





Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament


