

Gospel John 6:37~40



Reflection: This Sunday we celebrate the Commemoration of All Souls. The gospel is a short one, but it contains a powerful message. Jesus is our welcoming Savior who will not reject anyone that His Father sent to Him. Jesus shares with us that the will of God is that everyone will be raised on the last day to spend all eternity with Him. What a comforting proclamation. 



SAFEGUARD OUR CHILDREN Facts about physical grooming

The term "grooming" refers to the way in which a predator tries to mold and set up his victims and their families, in order to gain access to a child and cause harm, all while appearing innocent. The first of the three types of grooming is physical, and it involves touch. A predator starts with innocent touches back pats, appropriate hugs — and then moves on to tickling, wrestling, hugging, conditioning the child to increasing levels of physical contact.
