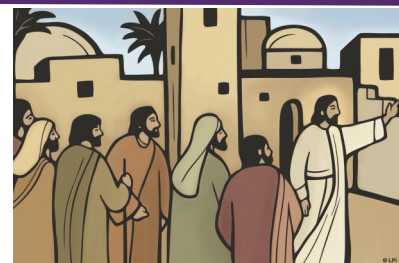

Gospel
John 6:37-40



Reflection: This Sunday we celebrate the Commemoration of All Souls. The gospel is a short one, but it contains a powerful message. Jesus is our welcoming Savior who will not reject anyone that His Father sent to Him. Jesus shares with us that the will of God is that everyone will be raised on the last day to spend all eternity with Him. What a comforting proclamation. Let us all do our part to spread this loving God's love and follow His will so that we will be worthy of our eternal reward.

Question: *This is the will of the one who sent me.* How can I better discern God's will for my life? How can I support the Church's mission as a faithful disciple?

Faith Response: This week, if possible, visit a Catholic cemetery and pray for those who have died, especially those who have no one to pray for them.

SAFEGUARD OUR CHILDREN

Facts about physical grooming

The term “grooming” refers to the way in which a predator tries to mold and set up his victims and their families, in order to gain access to a child and cause harm, all while appearing innocent. The first of the three types of grooming is physical, and it involves touch. A predator starts with innocent touches — back pats, appropriate hugs — and then moves on to tickling, wrestling, hugging, conditioning the child to increasing levels of physical contact. Over time, the predator conditions the child to accept all forms of touch, progressing to sexual contact. For more information about physical grooming, read the VIRTUS® article
